

PRIMARY GRADE DISCIPLINE PLAN

NO TOLERANCE FOR PHYSICAL VIOLENCE

- If a child is intentionally physically violent (hitting, slapping, forceful pushing, etc.)
 - Both students will be sent to the office immediately
 - One or both may be sent home as determined by the principal or her delegate.
- Teachers will keep a document notebook recording individual student issues and interactions with students and parents.
- Disruption in the classroom may mean that the child is removed from the classroom and taken to a different location or classroom for a certain period of time.

BEHAVIOR CARDS:

Each teacher uses a behavior or card system daily. Students are given warnings using the card system throughout the day.

- **Green:** Good work, keep it up!
- **Yellow:** A verbal warning was given, and behavior did not change, the child turns their card to yellow. A five minute time out is given.
- **Red:** Behavior continues; child turns their card to red. They will have a loss of recess time** for five minutes.
- **Blue:** Behavior continues; child turns their card to blue. The "last chance" card will necessitate parent contact from teacher (phone call, note, email, etc.) and a loss of recess time**.

If a child has three or more "parent contacts" in a week (three "last chance" cards) the student will serve a detention. The detention will be served on the following day of the third last chance.

Detention is available Monday through Thursday for 30 minutes after school. The student will serve the detention on the day following **their third "last chance" card**. If the student is unable to serve their detention due to scheduled appointments, the student will need to serve their detention on the next available school day. Each classroom teacher is in charge of detention for their students. The teacher will determine an age appropriate detention activity. If the student fails to serve their detention, Sister Kathy, Principal, will contact the family.

***Loss of recess time: During **morning or afternoon recess**, the child will run or walk (their choice) on the playground in a designated area. They are not allowed to talk or play with other children. Classroom teachers will give the child a card to hand to the staff person on duty. The staff person will sign the card at the end of recess to give back to the student. The student must show the card to the teacher when they return to the classroom. **During the lunch**, the staff on lunch duty will supervise the walking either in the MPC (outside depending on weather).*
